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Can a good assessment help?

- ► Children in first 6 years of school
- ► In foster care
- Interviews with a psychologist and special education teacher
- ► Tailored intervention programme including e.g. one to one teaching, working memory training
- Structured assessment of
 - Cognition
 - ► Emotional problems
 - ▶ Reading, writing and mathematical skills
- Very positive results, including increases in cognitive skills
